We're here to help employers report new hires!

Employers reporting newly hired employees help California Child Support Services locate parents, establish Income Withholding Orders (IWOs), and enforce existing IWOs.

New Hires and Rehires are reported to the Employment Development Department (EDD) using form DE 34 and Independent Contractors are reported using form DE 542.

Employer's:

- California Employer Account Number
- Branch Code
- Federal Employer Identification Number (FEIN)
- Legal Business Name and Address
- Contact Person Name and Phone Number

Employee's:

- Full Name
- Social Security Number
- Home Address
- Start-of-work Date

Report the following employees within 20 days of their start of work date:

⇒New Hires

⇒Rehires

⇒Independent Contractors

Employees rehired after being separated for at least 60 consecutive days, as well as Independent Contractors that are paid \$600 or more, or contracted for \$600 or more, or file a form 1099 for services provided must also be reported to EDD within 20 days.
